
## 2. Verified Claim Retrieval

- → ranking of verified claims according to their potential to verify

Fact check: President Donald Trump donates his salary, but he still makes money






### 3. Evidence Retrieval



#### 1+5. Check-Worthiness

**Transformers**. BERT, RoBERTa, AraBERT, multilingual BERT **Classifiers**. NNs, SVMs **Features.** Word embeddings, LASER, engineered features

#### 2. Verified Claim Retrieval

**Transformers**. BERT **Scorers.** SVM, similarity, Terrier, Elastic search

#### 3. Evidence Retrieval

Feature-based similarity between claims and web page snippets

#### 4. Claim Verification

Supervised model fed by engineered features



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
